The Greenwich Council BSA has been reviewing and discussing the ever-changing guidelines for the use of Masks (and all Covid protocols) in an effort to keep Covid 19 from entering our camp. This is happening as a year-round effort to keep our current and future campers and staff safe. While we do not have all the information needed to make decisions yet for this summer, we are constantly reviewing what is available to us. We utilize information from the National Boy Scouts of America, ACA (American Camping Association), State of CT Health Department, Office of Early Childhood Development, CDC, and the Greenwich Health Department. We are always looking out for the safety and health of our campers and staff, as this is first and foremost, our priority.

Greenwich Council BSA is committed to operating our camp and our programs with the guidance and information provided by the appropriate authorities. Camp operations may have to be modified by the time camp begins or during camp as the situation dictates. The changes may include but are not limited to the following:

- Wearing masks in buildings or outside around camp
- The use of cohorts
- Adjusting of program
- The cancelling of various programs if needed

The policies and any modifications will be shared with all parents/guardians prior to the start of camp and or the start of the week.
